6. Focus Areas:
 - a) National Life Bike / Ped Update (Anthony) – Project is to start soon; they will likely be installing a ped walkway on the way down the hill, an uphill bike lane, and a downhill share the road. National Life is attempting to change the ordinance for on street parking at top of hill (by maintenance entrance). On the hill a separated lane would be ideal, but may be expensive and make snow removal an issue.
