Review of Action Items – The ATF application is posted on the City website. The posting on FPF was completed by Heather. Traffic calming policy draft is expected by March.

Review of City Council Updates – Relevant items to MTIC were presented by Constantinos. Heather and Mark expressed interest on the stakeholders meeting for Old Country Club Road. Anthony expressed interest on the future parking task force committee. **Action** - Anthony will attend the 12/12 City Council meeting for questions on complete streets.

Mowatt Park – The City Council is considering development of a City park in the location of the former Montpelier Beverage. Four options were discussed – building with parking; building without parking; park with parking; park without parking. There was discussion and input from each member/staff on their view. **MOTION** - Ian will represent the MTIC at the City Council meeting in favor of parking with greenspace while allowing potential for future development with the expectation of support for removal of parking on Barre Street for the path connector.

GMTA Bus Routes – Action - it was agreed that there should be a near term future agenda item for Chris Loyer to present on the “Next Gen” plan. **Action** - Jenn to coordinate with Chris.

ATF Budget Discussion – Corey presented on the ATF budget and noted there was discussion at the CIP meeting regarding a change in the source of funds for the ATF budget which would also integrate ATF into CIP. Jonathan added a brief summary of CIP items relevant to MTIC.

Covered Bike Parking – It was noted that the covered bike parking proposal had surfaced with the complete streets group. It was agreed that covered parking is supported but more discussion is needed on the location. It was noted that there will be a potential future presentation on the e scooters, which is possible at the January 9 meeting.

Meeting Closed – The meeting was ADJOURNED at 7:58 by unanimous consent
