**Walk Friendly Communities Application**

The members, noting that the Walk Friendly Communities application is a submission by the City of Montpelier, discussed the mechanics of obtaining approval of the draft by the City by the June 15 submission date. It was decided that since the City Council established the Committee and specified that one of its duties was to prepare the application, the draft submission should be provided to the City Council for its approval for submission. After discussion, the Committee adopted a goal of providing the final draft application to the City Council for its May 28 meeting.

The members reviewed with Hannah Reckhow the remaining work to be done to get the application to final draft status and what the members could do to assist her effort. It was agreed to meet again on May 20 to review and discuss the draft application.
