Walk Friendly Communities Application

Hannah presented a draft of the Walk Friendly Communities Application for Montpelier. The members offered comments and suggestions for changes.

The members discussed how to proceed with the application. There was a consensus that presenting the application to the City Council, which had specified making the application for the Walk Friendly designation as one of the Committee's primary responsibilities, would serve as a useful opportunity to communicate the Committee's activities and issues to the Council. The members discussed issues, particularly including the City's crosswalks, that should be included in any discussion with the Council.
