

MTIC meeting August 6, 2019 – DRAFT minutes

Committee Members in attendance: Jenn, Corey, Jack, Kevin, Heather, Dona, Constantinos, Celia, Kate

Public in attendance: Richard Shier, Elizabeth Parker

Agenda: motion to approve by HLV, second by Jack, approved

Minutes: motion to approve by Constantinos, second by Jack, approved

Public Comment: deferred to relevant topics already on agenda

Farmer's Market bike parking, report by Constantinos: working well, getting good use – especially on sunny days; looking for volunteers for assistance

Microtransit: Dona mentioned, shared small study by VIA and white paper by VTrans; VTrans has applied for grant for pilot program

Barre/Main Scoping updates: reports on public meeting – well-attended but mixed consensus on which alternative was preferred; any action needed from MTIC? Resolution previously made and voted on in May regarding indicating preference for roundabouts at Barre/Main and Memorial/Main.

Dona motions to indicate preference for roundabout at School/Main, Celia seconds. All in favor.

Discussion about consistency of traffic management options considered. Celia commented.

Heather makes motion for MTIC to support rapid implementation plan. Motion rescinded.

Constantinos makes motion to support removal of parking on south side of Barre from Rec to Main Street to allow for rapid implementation alternative shared use path. Stephen seconded. All in favor.

Downtown Master Plan: Consultant beginning data gathering and going to farmer's market to collect public input. Waiting on decisions on Barre/Main Scoping Study.

ATF Requests: Corey reported a couple requests have been filed; One is Drive Electric event – should be rerouted to Complete Streets Committee; Another for a banner for “Bike Parking” to go with city-owned bike racks; Need to develop process for protocol for notification of award – Dona is going to work on this

Drive Electric Event: Should MTIC be an organizational supporter? Constantinos makes motion to be an Organizing Supporter. Jack seconds. All in favor.

Traffic calming: Corey going to pull together entire document and will share with the workgroup. Plan on reviewing as full committee next month.

Skateboarding rule proposed amendment: Discussion on Mayor's email and specific request to modify ordinance; Larger discussion on ordinances being outdated – should any rewrite involve a broader view? Would like to hear directly from skateboarders; What is record of enforcement in last decade? Jack to reach out to MPD for data; Next meeting, committee members should come prepared and review Section 10

Cross VT Trail Update: Kim not present, discuss delayed
