Call to order by the Chair: The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Kirby Keeton.

Approval of the agenda: The agenda was deemed approved.

Comments from the Chair: Kirby wanted to remind the other commissioners that the focus for the near future is working on the City Plan and to postpone the vision statement until a few chapters of the City Plan have been completed.
