 - a. Craig: Road Work expected May 1st, is that the Rt2 paving. Yes.
5. Updates
 - a. DPW
 - Rt 2 Paving - started on Moretown to Bailey Ave, will do full paving, then switch over to the rest on Berlin St and River St
 - Barre St path - paperwork submitted. Begin preliminary design while environmental review is ongoing.
 - Barre/Main traffic signal - design started with contracted consultant. Discussion with railroad on their collocated project. Joint meeting expected soon. Fencing the Rail line from North Branch bridge to granite street bridge.
 - Junction Rd/dog river Rd scoping - Start consultant selection for the Junction Rd/dog river Rd scoping, funding starts July 1.
 - Terrace street traffic calming - Data collection expected first week of May. Data should be available at June meeting.
 - East State St – presented to council, they agreed with the proposed layout and committee recommendation on bike/ped path on south side.
 - b. Complete Streets Committee
 - Bike Rodeo, Sunday May 7th Bike 10-12 at Montpelier high school
 - Trash recommendations provided to DPW. DPW is looking in to compacting trash cans that can be leased.
 - Discussing safe routes to school.
 - 6 Adult bike education workshops from, Tuesday in the memorial room in city hall at 6pm.
 - Complete streets got money from city council, to support their efforts and campaigns.
6. Other business
 - a. Flashing Cross Walks – study suggest that the RRFB configuration is better at influencing traffic. Recommended that VTTrans adopt the signs for roads below 35.
